

Full Value Contract

We at the Big Sky Youth Empowerment Project (BYEP) are dedicated to providing exceptional opportunities for youth to have fun, learn, and make connections with others. We provide all necessary gear/instruction for the youth to participate in our seasonal programs. We ask in return that youth participate in all BYEP events. This includes all activity days and workshop evenings. By fully participating, the gear/instruction that we provide is yours to keep at the end of the program. However, if the youth misses more than two scheduled activities without excuse, the youth will be asked to no longer be part of the program and return all gear that was given to him/her for use in the program. We understand that certain emergencies arise keeping certain youth from participating occasionally (i.e., sickness, family emergencies, etc.). All of these emergencies need to be communicated to the program director as soon as possible.

Other grounds for removal from the program include but are not limited to:

- Drug and/or Alcohol use during BYEP scheduled events.
- Violence (verbal, sexual, physical, emotional) directed toward any member of the program.
- Breaking of any law during BYEP scheduled events.

Informed Consent:

Our three main goals at BYEP are; to have fun, to learn a new skill in the outdoors, and to make new relationships. Occasionally, during the course of the program a participant discloses information about themselves or others which we are required to report to the participant's parent/legal guardian and the Department of Family Services.

1. In the case that we have reason to believe that the participant is at risk for doing serious harm to him/herself.
2. In the case that we have reason to believe that the participant is at imminent risk for doing harm to others.
3. In the case that we have reason to believe that a child under the age of 18 is being/has been physically abused, sexually abused, or neglected by a parent or caretaker or that there is suspected abuse of a disabled or elderly person.
