Montana: Bozeman — The Yellowstone Park Foundation protects and enhances the park's resources, director of communications Christine Ganas Weinheimer says. Since 1996, the organization has funded more than 150 projects and raised more than \$50 million, she says. . . . Pete MacFadyen says he felt he could reach at-risk youth better by teaching them how to snowboard or ski than by using traditional counseling methods. So he started Big Sky Youth Empowerment Project, an adventure-based mentoring program that has served 253 kids in seven years. In the summer, activities include horseback riding, white-water rafting, fly-fishing and rock climbing.
